2) The whole idea of the event

The event is not a race or a competition, so it has no categories or classifications according to a rider's

ability, either. We neither time nor rank you. It's an event in which you enjoy mountain biking on

old or abandoned mountain trails in a safe manner.

The whole course makes up a big loop in which the place to start and finish is the same, It is made up

of paved roads and old unpaved trails. You will climb up hills mainly on road, and go mainly down old

single tracks. We believe that the abandoned narrow trails we had a hard time finding will make you

very much excited. We would like you to ride the way you derive as much fun as possible from old

trails biking. You can ride as slowly as you like if you meet the time limits. If you'd like to compete

with other riders, it's ok, but at your own risk.

At the onsite check-in between 7:00AM-7:45AM, we'll hand out a route map to each of you. You have

to read it to travel the course, but many signs we set up in the fields will show you which way to go, so

probably you won't get lost. Or if you are not confident, you will be able to find someone to depend on

in the participants and ride with them. If you are in trouble, you'll find our on-the-course staffers

easily.

All the riders are divided into small groups. The groups will start at a minute interval. There will be 4

check points on the way. At each point, you have to stop for our staff members to confirm your safe

arrival. To your joy, you'll find some food and drinks there. If you cannot get to the check points

within the time limits, you have to give up going forward and return to the start point following the

designated routes.

The time limits at each check points are written on the map handed out at the onsite check-in.

When you get back to the start point, never fail to go to the head quarters and tell the staff members

you have finished, which is required to confirm you are safe and sound. After that, you will get some

nice things to eat for free!

If you are injured, it will be covered by insurance, which is included in the entry fee.
